

UI GUIDE Programmer Announcement – North Carolina

The Employment Security Commission of North Carolina is seeking IT programming staff resources with extensive experience in the UI GUIDE benefits system to assist current North Carolina development staff with major modifications to its UI GUIDE system. A minimum of three years hands-on experience in the development, maintenance and support of the UI GUIDE mainframe COBOL benefit payment system is required. The specific IT staff skills required for this position include:

- Extensive experience and understanding of a state UI GUIDE based COBOL/CICS system.
- Extensive experience and understanding of UI GUIDE based data structures, in VSAM flat file format.
- Hands-on experience in modifying UI GUIDE based application programs including the addition of new components and functionality.
- Thorough knowledge of the requirements for implementation of the EUC and EB programs, and understanding their associated business rules.
- Demonstrated ability in the detection and correction of deficiencies or errors in UI GUIDE based COBOL/CICS application code and data.
- Understanding of UI GUIDE based system documentation
